




Feelings of Respect

How respected do you feel at this school? (N=130)
















How do you prefer to receive information from your child's school? (N=130)




Have you required interpretation services? (N=129)

I was satisfied with the interpreter support I received. (N=16)




Which of the following helped you engage in your child's education? (N=124)





Thinking about your ability to engage in your child's education this school year, was your engagement improved by the availability of technology? (N=127)









Internet Access

Do you have regular access to the internet? (N=128)









Feelings of Respect: Comparison Over Time

How respected do you feel at this school?



How respected does your child feel at this school?




Dimension Scores: Comparison Over Time






























Hispanic or Latino/Latina

Is your child Hispanic or Latino/Latina? (N=124)






What is your child's race? Select all that apply. (N=114)






Food Assistance

What best describes your child's food situation? (N=124)




English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Services

Does your child receive English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) services? (N=130)




Special Education Services


Does your child have a 504 plan? (N=129)
